Registration and cancellation

The registration is for a minimum of one Term, equivalent to the period of one trimester, and automatically extends for the successive terms.

The termination of the contract must be written and has to be sent in at least 1 week before the end of the Term. If the cancellation is not sent on time, the customer is obliged to pay the full price for the successive term. No exceptions will be made.

In addition, you authorise AIM to contact you via phone, email, post and any other means communicated to you by members of the AIM team.

Changes to the Terms and Conditions

AIM reserves the right to add, delete or make changes to its Terms and Conditions where this will assist or enhance the proper delivery of its services.

Changes may be made to:

- Refresh the content to ensure it is fit for purpose
- Reflect changes in sector guidance
- Incorporate feedback from students

As a student of AIM, we will give you notice of any proposed change. AIM will take all steps to minimize disruption to students.

AIM reserves its right to make changes or cancel a class before the start of the Term in circumstances where:

- an insufficient number of applications means that the student experience cannot be guaranteed; or
- the class is no longer viable for academic, regulatory, legal, commercial, financial or other reasons. In such cases, AIM will offer you an alternative class or, where this is not possible, make a full refund of monies paid to AIM by that date.

AIM will do all that it can to provide the promised educational services. Sometimes circumstances beyond the control of AIM may mean that it cannot provide such service, such as unanticipated illness, absence of key staff, severe weather, and other exceptional circumstances. In such cases, AIM reserves the right to exceptionally cancel the class or to modify the schedule.

Conduct

1. Please come with clean shoes (no street or expensive shoes) in case you forget your shoes you have to dance bare feet;
2. Wear comfortable training clothes and bring water (no other drinks will be allowed in the room);
3. Jewellery, watches or phones are not allowed during class;
4. Be on time! AIM reserves the right to prohibit a student to take part of the class if they are late;
5. Please note that AIM declines any responsibility in case of an accident, theft or loss during class as well as the way to and from the classes, excluding cases of negligence or wilful misconduct by AIM staff.

Suspension

In case of non-compliance of the terms defined by the present Terms and Conditions, site rules, premises or teachers, AIM can suspend a student temporarily or permanently from all classes. The suspension will be written, and no refund will be made.

Physical Contact

We strive to offer teaching that is individual, professional, and thus “hands-on”. It is appropriate for a teacher to manually and physically position a student to explain a point of instruction or to demonstrate an individual flaw in his or her technique. Appropriate physical contact between students and teachers in class is essential to training and continued development of technique. Teachers may use their hands, and occasionally a foot or knee, to illustrate a concept to a student or to adjust parts of a student’s body.

Both teachers and students will treat any physical contact with due sensitivity and care, and a student has the right to immediately stop a particular contact if it makes her or him feel uncomfortable in any way.

Image rights

The student or his legal guardian authorizes AIM to take pictures or videos of the students in relation to the activities of the studio. AIM has the right to use the material freely for personal or commercial use.

Data protection

Your information will be saved in our database in order to maintain contact with you in relation to any changes or extra activities in concerning AIM. It will also be used to provide you with support and services, managing student finances and taking disciplinary action if appropriate.

Where you have a disability, information you have provided in connection with that disability will be processed by Marc Folschette for the purposes of assessing what, if any, adjustments are required. Information concerning your disability will be disclosed to other relevant staff who would need to be in possession of such information for the purposes of implementing any or all of the adjustments identified. You have the right to request that information about your disability is not disclosed to such staff and while all effort will be made to implement adjustments, the request for confidentiality may in some circumstances prevent those adjustments being made. AIM will only disclose personal data where there is a legal basis for doing so, always in compliance with the data protection regulations in force.

COVID-19

In order to protect everyone we ask you to inform AIM and to stay home in case you show any signs of sickness or got in contact with someone affected by the virus. The dance room will be ventilated and cleaned before and between every class. Parents have to leave their kids at the front door, excluded are the parents of the Baby AIM students. Before entering the dance room everyone should wear a mask and has to use disinfectant. During the classes the students can take their masks off. Water bottles or any other belongings should not be shared. We will keep you updated if there are any changes of the measures.
